

## **REPORT ON SELECTION OF AALJ CONFERENCE SITE**

We have received 490 responses to the survey. The bottom line is that most folks want to go to either Santa Fe or San Antonio; these are followed by Park City, Phoenix downtown, Oakland, San Juan and Phoenix suburb, in that order.

In response to the question as to other cities we should consider, the respondents were overwhelmingly enthusiastic about Chicago, significantly ahead of Boston, San Diego and Portland.

In response to Q15, “If you have not attended a conference in the past or in the last several years, is there something that would encourage you to attend?”, cost was the number one concern, followed by location.

In response to Q13, concerning suggested topics for the conference, the most popular were mental impairments, significantly ahead of medical issues generally, visual impairments, retirement, and ethics (several requested another appearance by Michael Josephson).
